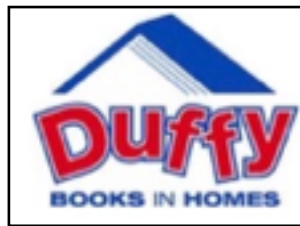
PIZZA FUNDRAISER
